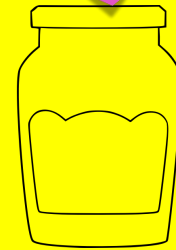

I only write or say what I would dare to say in person



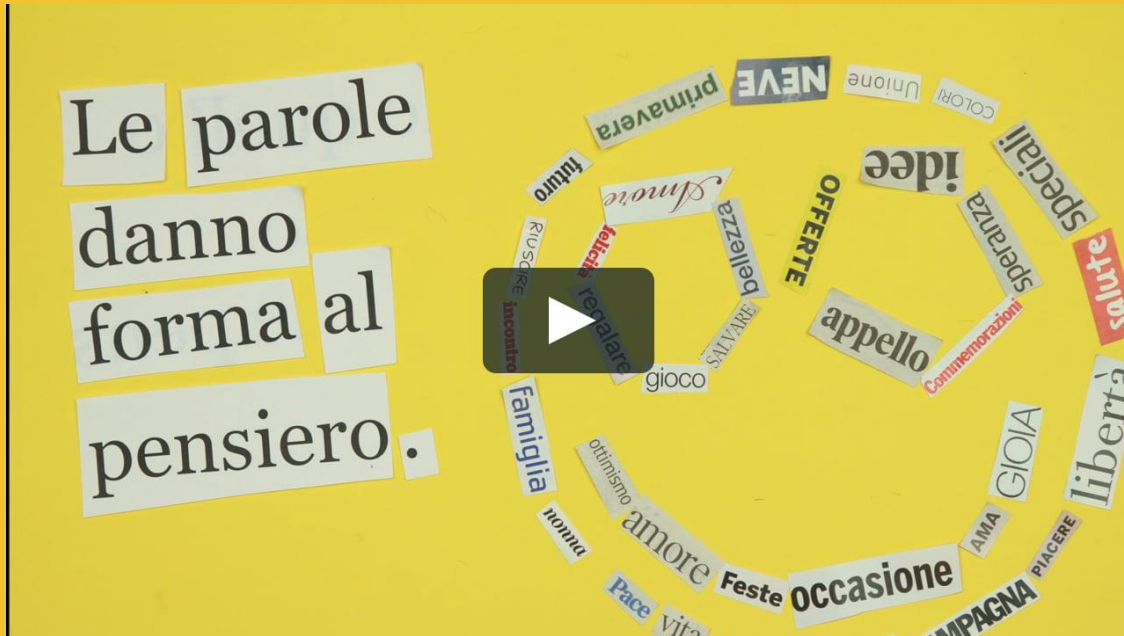
You are what you communicate

I take all the time I need to express my views in the best possible way.

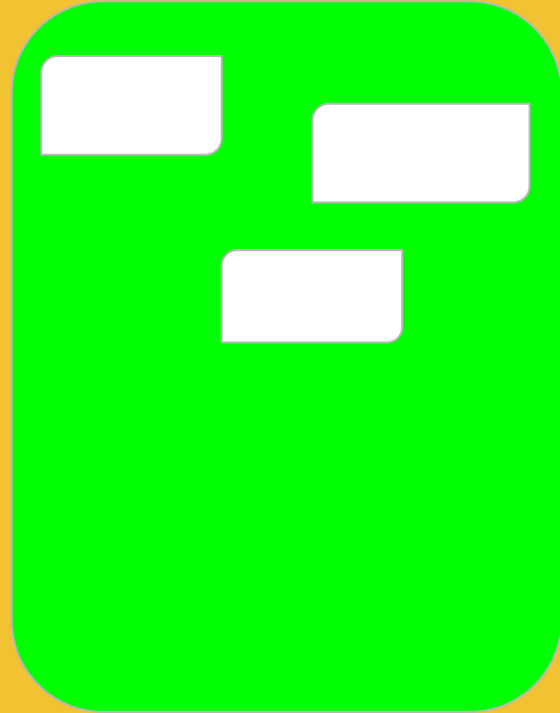


Now it's your turn ... you need
